Day 1

Meals Included: Lunch

Home Cities to Bonners Ferry

Welcome aboard your deluxe coach as your tour begins in St. Albert with pickups in Edmonton and Leduc. Travel south along Highway 2 with pickups in Red Deer and Calgary. After our meet & greet luncheon in Black Diamond and a stop at the Duty Free store at Kingsgate for some shopping, we will continue onto Bonners Ferry for the night. Try your luck in the casino at the Kootenai River Inn Casino & Spa.

Day 2

Bonners Ferry to Seattle

Sit back and enjoy the scenery as you travel south through Idaho before turning west past Sandpoint and continuing into Washington. We will stop for a coffee break in Spokane before we carry onto Ellensburg where we will stop for lunch on your own. After lunch we will continue west to Tukwila, south Seattle, for the evening.

Seattle to Long Beach

After a complimentary breakfast, we will head south on I5 and make a stop at Mount St. Helens Visitor Centre. We will be educated on the historical significance of the landscape before and during the eruption. As we travel west along the Columbia River we arrive at the Astoria-Megler Bridge for a photo opportunity at Dismal Nitch. The Astoria-Megler Bridge stretches 4.1 miles or 21,474 feet. We will then make our way to Long Beach for a visit to the Cranberry Museum and then check into our hotel.

Day 4

Free Day in Long Beach

After a complimentary breakfast, you have a free day in Long Beach to explore this beach town that boasts the "longest beach in the world." Visit the World Kite Museum and Marsh's Free Museum, take a long walk on the beach, or along the boardwalk. There are so many things to see and do in this seaside town you will be busy all day exploring.

Day 5

Long Beach to Coos Bay

We depart today and travel further south along the Pacific Coast. We will stop at the Tillamook Cheese Factory where you can sample and buy cheese or have some delicious ice cream. Next, we will continue south along the coast stopping in Newport for lunch and browsing on your own. From here we will discover the beautiful coastal scenery as we make our way to Coos Bay for the evening.

Day 6

Coos Bay to Eureka

Our day will consist of driving down the Oregon Coast stopping along the way for picturesque opportunities. We will also be seeing some of those giant redwood trees as we make our way towards Eureka. An amazing diversity of life exists at Redwood National and State Parks. The ancient coast redwood ecosystem preserved in the parks contains some of the planet's most majestic forests.

Eureka to San Francisco

After breakfast, we will continue to follow the coastline. We will stop at Founders Grove which is the most-visited grove in Humboldt Redwoods and a major North Coast redwood attraction. Continuing south, we will stop in Healdsburg for lunch on our own before arriving at the Marin Suites Hotel, minutes from all that San Francisco area has to offer.

Day 8

Golden Gate Bridge & San Francisco City Tour

First we travel over the Golden Gate Bridge into San Francisco and enjoy a city tour with a local guide who will show you the sights of the San Francisco Bay area including Fisherman's Wharf, Pier 39, the Haight Ashbury District, Market Street, and Union Square. Downtown we will ride the cable car which is both a unique experience and a fun means of transportation. For those who have chosen to upgrade, take a boat ride for a tour of Alcatraz.

Day 9

Napa Valley

Today we travel through the lush mesmerizing landscape of the Napa Valley where we will board the Napa Valley Wine Train for an excursion with an included luncheon and lounge service. The train will take you on a 36-mile round-trip discovery to St. Helena and back.
