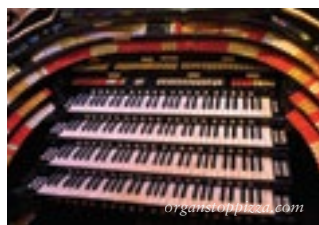


Day 8

St. Albert to Helena

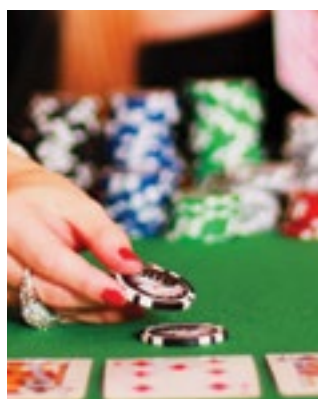
