Day 1

Meals Included: None

Flights to Toronto

Your tour begins with a Westjet Flight from Edmonton to Toronto. Here we will be transported to Niagara Falls where we will be staying for the next two evenings. Upon arrival to the area, we will have passes to the Niagara SkyWheel for the most spectacular view of the falls, after which we will have free time at Clifton Hill for you to browse on your own. We will then transport you to your hotel for the evening where you may dine in the restaurant or choose one of many restaurants close by.

Day 3

Flights to Deer Lake

This morning we will be transported back to the Toronto Airport for our flights into Deer Lake, Nfld. Upon arrival, we will meet our local NL guide and coach driver and be transported to Rocky Harbour, here we will stop at the Visitor Centre for a brief intro to Gros Morne National Park. We will then be transported to our hotel, The Ocean View, and this evening in the lounge we will be welcomed to Newfoundland at the Anchors Aweigh Show, a mix of comedy and music that will have you laughing and singing along all night.

Day 2

Niagara Falls, Local Vineyard and Guided Tour

Today features a Local guide joining us for a boat tour to Niagara Falls and a tour and tasting at Jackson-Triggs winery. After we have partaken of some divine wines at the winery, we will continue our area tour including Niagara on the Lake where we will have lunch on your own and time for browsing to top off a full day in Niagara Falls.

Gros Morne National Park

We will start your tour of Gros Morne today with a visit to the Bonne Bay Marine Centre. We will then head to the Lobster Cove Head Lighthouse for a presentation, then continue on to Broome Point and then off to Cow Head for lunch. Afterwards we will carry on north to the Arches (a must see) and then on to our destination for the evening, Torrent River Inn, where we will enjoy a scrumptious Cod dinner, after which you are then free to explore on your own for the rest of the evening.

Day 5

We continue on to our destination of St. Anthony's for the next two evenings. We will join Northland Discovery Iceberg and Whale Tours for a majestic boat ride to see the icebergs. Day Trip to Twillingate

Today we will enjoy a day trip to Twillingate. On the way we will stop at the Beothuk Interpretive Centre for a video and tour and to enjoy the Ancient Gardens. Afterwards, we will continue to Twillingate located in Iceberg Alley, for a guided tour, wine tasting and lunch at Auk Island Winery. We'll also have time to visit the Twillingate Museum and Craft Centre and enjoy a short stop at the Long Point Lighthouse poised high in the cliffs. We will then retrace our steps back to Gander for the evening.

Day 11

Clarenville

We will travel to Trinity today, one of the oldest communities in North America, then we will carry on to Cape Bonavista, where you can experience the cliffs and coastal scenery. We will visit many coves along the way where John Cabot landed in 1497, and visit the Ryan Premises National Historic Site. Returning to Clarenville we will take you along the Bonavista Bay Highway past Kings Cove for a different scenic route back.

Day 6

A short journey to L'Anse aux Meadows on the Great Northern Peninsula will start our day this morning. We will then, in the afternoon, be visiting the Norstead Viking Village for a guided tour. Join costumed interpreters, listen to mysterious Viking tales, step aboard the full-scale replica of the Viking ship "Snorri" and learn how the Vikings mastered the North Atlantic, it's bound to be a fun and informative day. This evening, once we return, you can enjoy more of festivities in town for the Iceberg Festival.

Day 8

Corner Brook to Gander

Get set for some sightseeing today as we work our way to Gander for the next two evenings. En route we will stop at Kings Point for a tour of the Humpback Whale Museum, the world's largest concentration of summer humpback whales attracts a lot of attention here. We will then enjoy lunch at the By the Sea Inn. Once on the road again, as we enter Gander, we will visit the North Atlantic Aviation Museum, which highlights Gander's role in the development of Transatlantic Aviation. After an insightful visit at the Museum we will end our day at our accommodations for the evening, Sinbad Hotel and Suites and have the rest of the evening free to explore on your own.

Day 10

Gander to Clarenville

As we leave Gander today, we will enjoy a driving tour stopping at the Silent Witness Memorial, a tranquil park dedicated to the memory of the individuals who lost their lives in the Arrow Air crash, before heading north to Newton for a visit and lunch on your own at Barbour Living Heritage Village. Backtracking, we will then stop at the Dover Fault Lookout and Interpretation Centre, and then on to Joey's Lookout for a stretch and picture opportunities. Our day will find us ending in Clarenville for the next two evenings.

Day 12

Clarenville to St. John's

We depart today for our last city stop of the tour – St. John's. Along the way we will stop at Petty Harbour, a quaint fishing village. Then it's off to Cape Spear, the most easterly point in North America. Stand here with your back to the ocean and the entire North American population is to the west of you, face the ocean and the next stop east would be Ireland. We will then continue on to our destination accommodations for the evening, the Holiday Inn- St. John's, and then tonight we will enjoy a farewell supper on famous George Street.

Day 13

St. John's and Flights Home

Today before we depart for home we have a city tour of St. John's including Signal Hill. Be amazed at you have a 360 degree view of the harbour entering St. John's, the city below and learn how the first transatlantic wireless transmission was received here from a wireless Station in Cornwall, UK.
