After pickups in Edmonton and Leduc we will travel south with pickups in Red Deer, Calgary, High River, Fort Macleod and Cardston before stopping at the Duty Free and entering the U.S.A. at Carway. Following Hwy 89 South to Browning we turn west on Hwy 2 for a scenic drive along the edge of Flathead Lake as we arrive at Polson MT and KwaTaqNuk Resort and Casino for the next three evenings.

Time to gather your winnings and retrace our steps as we head back to St. Albert with new friendships and fond memories of your Polson Montana Flathead Lake Casino Tour.

Day 1

Meals Included: Lunch

St. Albert to Waterton National Park

Welcome aboard your deluxe coach as your tour begins in St. Albert. Travel south on Hwy 2 through Red Deer, Calgary & Okotoks. From Okotoks we will take Hwy 7 west to Hwy 22. Referred to as the "Cowboy Trail" we will continue to Black Diamond where we will stop for lunch. Afterwards, we will continue our journey to Crowsnest Pass and a stop at the Frank Slide Interpretive Centre. Learn about the rockslide that buried part of the mining town of Frank in 1903, when 82 million tons of limestone slid down Turtle Mountain. This is one of the largest landslides in Canadian history. From here we will continue south towards Pincher Creek, before arriving into Waterton National Park, your destination for the next 3 nights.

Day 2

Meals Included: None

Waterton

Today we will be exploring Waterton starting with a morning boat cruise with Waterton Shoreline Cruises. Enjoy some of the most spectacular mountain scenery the Rocky Mountains have to offer. After lunch we will continue exploring the area with a visit to Red Rock Canyon, Cameron Lake, Cameron Falls, the Bison Paddock and Prince of Wales Hotel.

Day 3

Meals Included: Supper

Cardston & Hillspring

Enjoy a leisurely morning with possibly a walk on the Townsite Loop or the Waterton Springs Interpretive Trail or maybe some shopping in town. After lunch we will head to Cardston with a visit to the Remington Carriage Museum. The Museum houses the largest collection of horse drawn vehicles in North America. Situated on 20 acres of prime parkland in Lee Creek Valley, the pastoral setting completes the picture of a long-past era. Leaving here we will head to Hillspring to enjoy the Music Legends Dinner show. The evening begins with a famous western dinner followed by the members of the Kunkel clan, a family bursting at the seams with talent, entertaining you.

Day 4

Waterton to Home Cities

Today we depart Waterton and begin our journey back to St. Albert, with our first stop at the Smashed-In-Head Buffalo Jump World Heritage Site. This is one of the oldest, most extensive and best-preserved sites illustrating the ways of the Indigenous people of the plains. The buffalo jump was used for years to kill buffalo by driving them off the 36 ft. high cliff. From here we will make our way to Fort MacLeod for lunch, then it's onto Hwy 2 north to Edmonton, returning home with new friends and fond memories of your Waterton National Park tour.
