Day 6

Gros Morne National Park

Your tour of Gros Morne continues with highlights featuring a visit to the Lobster Cove Lighthouse. Then you will head north to see the Arches and Broom Point, which is a restored traditional fishing premise that gives you a real glimpse into the vibrant lives of inshore fishing families of coastal Newfoundland. Return back to the hotel in Rocky Harbour tonight with some time to check out the lounge again, which almost always hosts some sort of live entertainment.

Day 7

Rocky Harbour to Port aux Basques

Today you will depart Gros Morne National Park. As you enter Corner Brook, you will have your first stop at the Captain Cook Historic Site and a city tour of Corner Brook. It is then time to say goodbye to our NL Guide as you make your way to Port aux Basques. Here, you will make your crossing to the mainland tomorrow morning.

Day 8

Ferry Crossing to Mainland

You will leave the island of Newfoundland today and take the ferry from Port aux Basques to North Sydney. It will be an afternoon of sailing and, upon landfall in Nova Scotia, you will be transported to your hotel in Baddeck for the next two evenings.

Day 9

The Cabot Trail

Today, you will meet your Nova Scotia Guide and enjoy the spectacular scenery of Cape Breton Island as you do a circle tour of the Cabot Trail. The Cabot Trail is considered one of the world's most scenic destinations with stunning ocean views, old growth forests, prehistoric rock scarred by glaciers, and the mysterious Cape Breton Highlands. Enjoy a picture stop and picnic lunch as we travel through Cape Breton Highlands National Park.

Day 10

Baddeck to Charlottetown

This morning, after breakfast, your day will start with a visit to the Alexander Graham Bell Museum. After a short tour, you will then depart for PEI. A short drive will find you at the Canso Causeway, where you will have a quick break. From here, you will head to Pictou, NS to await boarding of the Wood Islands Ferry for a short crossing to PEI. You then check into your hotel for the next two evenings.

Day 11

Charlottetown tour and Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place

Today, you will have a local guided tour of Charlottetown before departing for a North Shore tour and the Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place. We will also be in for a huge highlight and have an authentic welcome to PEI, with a Ceilidh and Oyster shucking demonstration!

Day 1

Home Cities to St. John's

Board your WestJet flight to Toronto, and then on to St. John's, where you will be greeted by your local Tour Director and picked up by Coach Atlantic and transported to your hotel for the next 2 evenings where you can get some rest after your long day of travelling.

Day 2

St. John's Tour

Wake up invigorated and ready to head to our first tour to Cape Spear - North America's most easterly point, as well as Signal Hill high above town as well as St. John's City Tour. You will head back to the hotel to freshen up before heading downtown to browse Water Street, and George Street. We will all then meet on Famous George Street at Bridie Malloys for a Screech Inn and Welcome dinner.

Day 3

Gander

Today we depart St. John's and head towards Gander. We will stop for a photo stop at Joseph Smallwood's Lookout, and then the Silent Witness Memorial. Upon arrival in Gander we will visit the North Atlantic Aviation Museum where you can try your luck on the flight simulator. As well, you will take in the Beyond Words Tour of the Gander Airport and hear how Gander opened its doors to the World on 9/11 when all North American flights were grounded. From here we will check into your hotel for the next two evenings.

Day 4

Twillingate Day Tour

You will enjoy a day trip to Twillingate today. Along the way, we will stop at the Beothuk Interpretive Centre for a video and tour, with a chance for a nice stroll through the Ancient Gardens. You will then continue to Twillingate, located in the heart of Iceberg Alley, for a scenic tour as well as lunch and wine tasting at a local winery. You will then have time to visit the Twillingate Museum and Craft Centre and have a short stroll behind to see the cemetery situated on the hill facing the sea. Aboard the coach once again, you will have a short stop at the Long Point Lighthouse poised high on the cliffs. You will then retrace your steps back to Gander for the evening.

Day 5

Gander to Rocky Harbour

This morning we make your way to Rocky Harbour. Upon arrival we have a visit to the Visitor Center for a short video presentation and information on Gros Morne National Park. Then we will check into your hotel to freshen up before heading to the evening Anchors Aweigh Show.

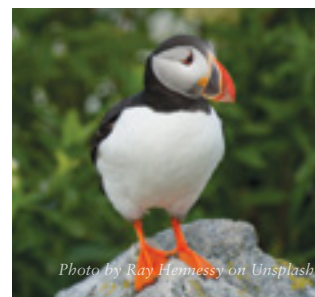

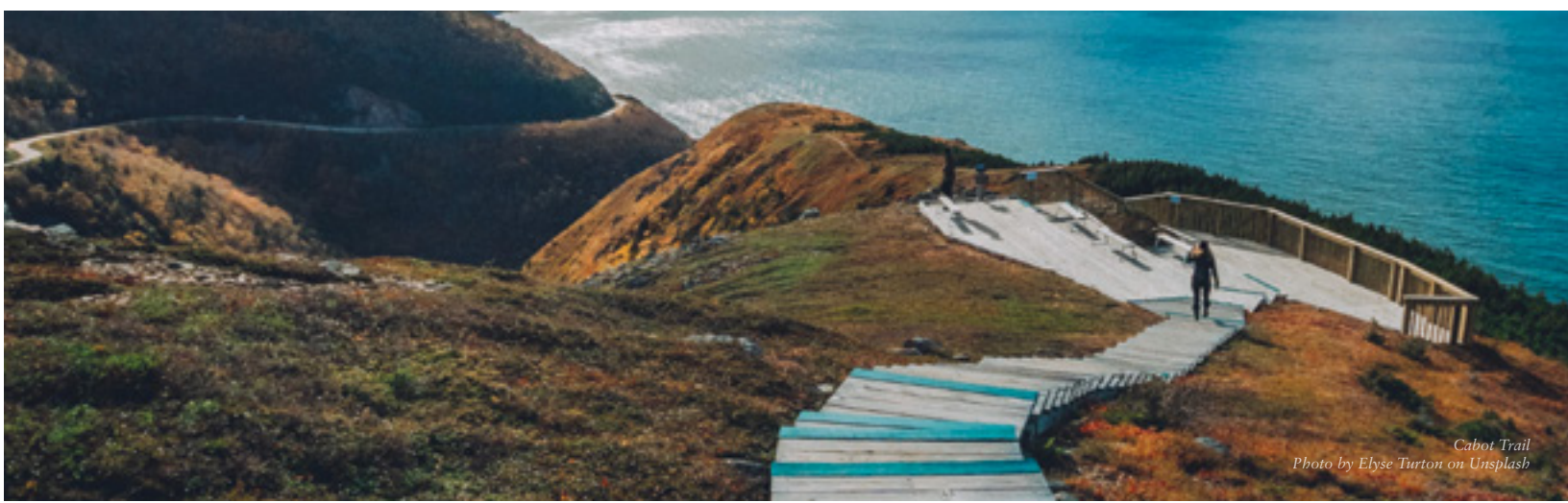
