#### Day 1

🍷 Meals Included: None

#### Edmonton to Halifax

Board your WestJet flight towards Halifax this morning, where you will be greeted by your local Tour Director. You will then be picked up by Coach Atlantic and transported to your hotel. This evening there will be a Welcome Reception where you can get to meet your fellow passengers. Get settled in your hotel where we enjoy a 2 night stay and prepare for tomorrow's start of a wonderful journey.

#### Day 2

#### Halifax, Peggy's Cove, Mahone Bay and Lunenburg

Today, after a complimentary breakfast you will meet your Nova Scotia Tour Guide and head to Peggy's Cove, Mahone Bay, Lunenburg, and tour the city of Halifax. There may be time to stop at the Fairview Lawn Cemetery, home of many of the unknown victims of the Titanic disaster. Afterwards, you can explore the boardwalk, the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, or shop at the many quaint shops on the boardwalk. Tonight you will get to enjoy an included Welcome dinner.

#### Day 3

🍷 Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

#### Halifax to Saint John

After your complimentary breakfast, you will depart Halifax. From here, you will make your way to Shediac for a picture stop at the World's largest Lobster. Then, it's time to board the Shediac Bay Cruises for a 2 ½ hour Lobster Tales cruise. You will learn about Lobster fishing, cooking lobster, tips on how to crack a lobster, the easiest way to eat it, and a meal fit for a king. (Alternative meals are available for non-seafood lovers or those with allergies). Then we are off to our Hotel in Saint John for another 2 night stay.

#### Day 4

🍷 Meals Included: Breakfast

#### Reversing Falls Skywalk, Saint John City Tour and St. Andrews By-the-Sea

After your complimentary breakfast, you will make your way to the recently opened Saint John Skywalk for a short video presentation and a walk on the skywalk to view the Saint John River and Reversing Falls Rapids. You will then depart for a city tour and an afternoon trip to St. Andrews By-The-Sea.

#### Day 5

🍷 Meals Included: Breakfast

#### Hopewell Rocks and Confederation Bridge

You will depart for a drive along the Bay of Fundy, which will lead you to the Hopewell Rocks Ocean Tidal Exploration Site. You will be given a guided tour and then have time for lunch on your own. We will then make our way to PEI across the Confederation Bridge, the longest bridge in the world crossing ice covered water (in winter of course). Once across, you will have a short stop at the Gateway Village, a 30 acre retail and tourism development park. You then continue onto your hotel destination in downtown Charlottetown, PEI for the next 2 evenings.

#### Day 6

🍷 Meals Included: Breakfast

#### Charlottetown and Anne of Green Gables Museum

Today, you will have a local guided tour of Charlottetown before departing for a North Shore tour and the Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place. We will also have an authentic welcome to PEI, a Ceilidh and Oyster shucking demonstration! This evening will then be free to explore Charlottetown on your own.

#### Day 7

🍷 Meals Included: Breakfast

#### Charlottetown to Baddeck

After breakfast, you will make the short drive to the Wood Island-Pictou Ferry for a short crossing back to Nova Scotia. You will then continue your tour and carry on across the Canso Causeway which connects to Cape Breton Island. Then, you will visit the Alexander Graham Bell Museum, giving you a glimpse into this world-famous inventor that helped shape the modern world. You then check into your hotel for the next two evenings.

#### Day 8

#### The Cabot Trail

Today, you will enjoy the spectacular scenery of Cape Breton Island, as you do a circle tour of the Cabot Trail. The Cabot Trail is considered one of the world's most scenic destinations with stunning ocean vistas, old-growth forests, prehistoric rock scarred by glaciers, and the mysterious Cape Breton Highlands. Enjoy a picture stop and picnic lunch as you travel through Cape Breton Highlands National Park. This evening, say farewell to your Nova Scotia Guide as you set out for Newfoundland tomorrow.

#### Day 9

#### Ferry to Port aux Basques

Today after breakfast, you will leave the mainland of Atlantic Canada and take the ferry from North Sydney, NS for an afternoon voyage to Port aux Basque, NL. Upon landfall, you will be transported to your hotel for the evening.

#### Port aux Basques to Rocky Harbour

Today, you depart for Gros Morne National Park with your first stop being in Corner Brook, where you will meet your Newfoundland Guide. You will then stop at the Captain Cook Historic Site, and enjoy a city tour of Corner Brook before carrying on to the Gros Morne Visitor Center for a short film and information about the park. You will then check into the Ocean View Hotel for the next two evenings.

#### Day 11

#### Rocky Harbour

Your tour of Gros Morne continues with your first visit being a stop at the Lobster Cove Lighthouse. You then head north to see the Arches and Broom Point, which is a restored traditional fishing premise that gives you a real glimpse into the vibrant lives of inshore fishing families of coastal Newfoundland. Upon your return to Rocky Harbour, you will have an entertaining evening at the "Anchors Aweigh" show

#### Day 12

#### Rocky Harbour to Gander

Today it is time to leave Gros Morne have a travel day to get to Gander for the next two nights. Along the way, you will stop in Grand Falls for lunch. Then upon arrival in Gander, check into your hotel for the next two evenings.

#### Twillingate Day Tour

You will enjoy a day trip to Twillingate today. Along the way, you will stop at the Beothuk Interpretive Centre for a video and tour with a chance for a nice stroll through the Ancient Gardens. You will then continue to Twillingate, located in the heart of Iceberg Alley, for a scenic tour, as well as lunch and wine tasting at a local winery. You will then have time to visit the Twillingate Museum and Craft Centre and have a short stroll to see the cemetery situated on the hill facing the sea. Aboard the coach once again, you will have a short stop at the Long Point Lighthouse poised high on the cliffs. You will then retrace your steps back to Gander for the evening.

#### Day 14

#### Gander to St. John's

Today you depart Gander for St. John's, you will visit the North Atlantic Aviation Museum where you can try your luck on the flight simulator. Once back on the coach, you will have a Beyond Words Tour for the story of when the world came to Gander on 9/11. From here, it's off to a stop at the Silent Witness Memorial, and a photo stop at Joseph Smallwood's Lookout. We then carry on to St John's for our final two evenings.

#### Day 15

#### St. John's Area

Wake up invigorated and ready to head to our tour to Cape Spear - North America's most easterly point, as well as Signal Hill high above town as well as St. John's City Tour. You will head back to the hotel to freshen up before heading downtown to browse Water Street, and George Street. We will all then meet on Famous George Street at Bridie Malloys for a Screech Inn and farewell dinner.
