**Day 1: Home Cities to St John's, NL****Meals Included: Small welcome reception with snacks**

Thursday, June 2nd: is your travel day to St. John's NL. Airport shuttle direct to the hotel is available to get you settled in quickly after your flights. For guests flying in before the 3rd you will be on your own to arrive at our hotel. This evening there will be a welcome reception where you can get to meet your fellow passengers. Get settled in your hotel where we enjoy a 2-night stay and prepare for tomorrow's start of a wonderful journey.

**Day 2: St John's, NL****Meals Included: Breakfast, Welcome Supper and Screech Inn**

Friday, June 3rd: Wake up invigorated, enjoy an included breakfast and get ready to head to our first tour to Cape Spear – North America's most easterly point, as well as Signal Hill high above town and a St. John's City Tour. You will head back to the hotel to freshen up before heading downtown to browse Water Street and George Street. We will then all meet on Famous George Street at Bridie Malloys for a Screech Inn and Welcome dinner. Are you ready to Kiss the cod fish and have a shot of Screech?

Afterwards we will head back to our hotel and get ready for our departure as it's all East from here starting in the morning, Next stop Gander!

**Day 3: St Johns to Gander, NL****Meals Included: Breakfast**

Saturday, June 4th: Once we finish our included breakfast we depart St. John's and head towards Gander. We will stop for a photo stop at Joseph Smallwood's Lookout, and then the Silent Witness Memorial. Upon arrival in Gander, we will visit the North Atlantic Aviation Museum where you can try your luck on the flight simulator. As well, you will take in the Beyond Words Tour of the Gander Airport and hear how Gander opened its doors to the World on 9/11 when all North American flights were grounded. From here we will check into your hotel for the next two evenings.

Get checked into our comfortable Sinbad's Hotel for the next two evenings where you will enjoy complimentary breakfasts as well as an attached Mystic Dining

#### **DAY 4 : Twillingate Day Tour**

##### **Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch**

Sunday, June 5th: After an included breakfast we will enjoy a day trip to Twillingate today. First, we will stop at the Beothuk Interpretive Centre for a video and tour, with a chance for a nice stroll through the Ancient Gardens. You will then continue to Twillingate, located in the heart of Iceberg Alley, for a scenic tour, as well as lunch & wine tasting at a local winery. You will have time to visit the Twillingate Museum and Craft Center, with a short stroll behind to see the cemetery situated on the hill facing the sea. Aboard your coach once again, you will have a short stop at the Long Point Lighthouse poised high on the cliffs for an opportunity to see some icebergs. You will then retrace your steps back to Gander for the evening.

**Twillingate:** is a town of 2,269 people located on the Twillingate Islands (“Toulinquet”) in Notre Dame Bay. The islands provide an excellent sheltered harbour and easy access to the rich fishing grounds nearby. In recent years, a causeway named after Walter B. Elliot was built, which connects it to the mainland via New World Island. Labeled as “The Iceberg Capital of the World”, the town is one of the oldest ports on the island. Imagine... a now-extinct people with a unique language and culture, thriving on the rich resources of the land and sea: seals, birds, fish...

**Beothuk Interpretive Centre:** 300 years ago, this site was a Beothuk village. Tour the Interpretation Centre where exhibits and artifacts foster an appreciation for this unique, and now vanished culture. From the Interpretation Centre, follow a 1.5 km groomed walking trail to the village site – today an outline of housepits is the only evidence of the Beothuk people who once lived here. Along the trail, a sculpture designed by renowned Newfoundland artist Gerald Squires evokes the tragedy of the Beothuks’ demise.

**Long Point Lighthouse:** one of the most photographed landmarks on the Northeast Coast of NewfLong Point Lighthouse, one of the most photographed landmarks on the Northeast Coast of Newfoundland, is located at Crow Head, Twillingate. More than 300 feet above sea level, this is a lookout point where thousands of visitors every panoramic view of the Atlantic Ocean with the possibility of viewing icebergs, whales, seals and sea birds.

Returning for our second night at Sinbad's Hotel you will have plenty of time to pack for tomorrow and perhaps still time for a stroll.

**DAY 5: Gander, NL to Rocky Harbour, NL**  
**Meals Included: Breakfast**

Monday, June 6th: After our included breakfast we make our way to Rocky Harbour. Upon arrival, we have a visit to the Visitor Center for a short video presentation and information on Gros Morne National Park. Then we will check into our overnight stay at The Ocean View hotel. You will have time to freshen up, have supper and maybe walk across the street to view the ocean all before heading to the hilarious and entertaining evening Anchors Aweigh Show.

No Newfoundland experience would be complete without the music and wit of a group of local performers, and Anchors Aweigh is the very best the Gros Morne region has to offer.

For many visitors, a leisurely stroll to The Anchor Pub in Rocky Harbour is a defining moment of their trip. Here, every Monday, Wednesday and Friday night during the summer, a group of five local performers gets together to entertain tourists and locals alike with a rousing three-hour show.

Filled with renditions of popular Newfoundland and Labrador songs, and sprinkled with wit and one-liners, the show has become one of the best attended in the whole province. Almost by accident, and practically overnight, the Anchors Aweigh band has found its way onto the list of 'things to do' for local residents and visitors alike.

**Day 6: Rocky Harbour, NL to Torrent River, NL**  
**Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch**

Tuesday, June 7th: After we finish our included breakfast we will start your tour of Gros Morne National Park today, first with a stop at the Lobster Cove Lighthouse for a presentation before continuing on to Broome Point and to Cow Head for an included lunch. Then we will carry on north to the Arches, and then on to Torrent River Inn, your destination for the evening. Get ready for some more local talent in the lounge this evening.

The Torrent River Inn boasts a proud tradition of welcoming visitors to the Great Northern Peninsula of Newfoundland and Labrador since 1963 with warm hospitality, fine food and quality accommodations. **DAY 7: Torrent River, NL to St Anthony, NL**  
**Meals Included: Breakfast**

Wednesday, June 8th: After our included breakfast we continue on to our destination of St. Anthony for the next two evenings. Here, you will join Northland Discovery Iceberg and Whale Tours for a majestic boat ride to see the icebergs. Afterward, you will visit the Grenfell Center and enjoy some of the activities of the Iceberg Festival. The Iceberg Festival celebrates the coming of spring in the north and the annual arrival of icebergs. It features music, food, entertainment, history, culture, great hospitality and of course, the magnificent icebergs. Get settled in at Hotel North St. Anthony for the next two evenings where we are sure you will love the small town charm.

Located in the heart of St. Anthony, Newfoundland – guests have convenient access to an adjacent shopping mall, major grocery store, pharmacy and Tim Hortons coffee shop. We are located directly on St. Anthony Harbour. With an attached Jungle Jim's eatery and more local restaurants close by you will find something for all appetites.

**Day 8: St Anthony Iceberg Festival activities**  
**Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner**

Thursday, June 9th: Once our included breakfast is finished we take a short journey to L'Anse aux Meadows on the Great Northern Peninsula to start your day. It's bound to be a fun and informative day. This evening, upon your return, we will enjoy an authentic Viking Feast for dinner.

L'Anse aux Meadows: At the tip of Newfoundland's Great Northern Peninsula lies the first known evidence of European presence in the Americas. Here Norse expeditions sailed from Greenland, building a small encampment of timber-and-sod buildings over 1000 years ago against a stunning backdrop of rugged cliffs, bog, and coastline, discover the fascinating archaeological remains of the Viking encampment, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1978. You'll meet costumed Viking interpreters as you tour the recreated base camp and discover original artifacts from this internationally renowned archaeological find.

The Great Viking Feast is made of two parts. The first is the meal. This consists of the following. Appetizer of possible mussels or cod tongues and salt capelin. The main course is a buffet of Jiggs Dinner, Moose stew, fish and brewis, Roast beef, Shrimp fried rice, Baked beans, and Garden Salad. The desert is a rhubarb crumb cake served with tea or coffee. The second being the interactive part of the evening. It is a light hearted look at a Viking court of law. We also have some dancing and reciting of Viking poems/proverbs. During the beginning of the evening our Vikings will explain the proceedings. They will advise you that you may make a charge against your travel companions if you wish. Once our Law speaker and group hears the case the verdict will be handed out. But be careful sometimes there may be a silver tongued devil in the group and the tables may get turned. The accuser may

indeed become the accused. Fun is had by all at the end of the night you will drink a toast and become official members of our Vikings clan.

**Day 9: St Anthony, NL to Cow Head, NL**  
**Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner**

Friday, June 10th: Today, after an included breakfast we make our way back through Gros Morne National Park and end up in Cow Head for the evening. Upon arrival, you will check into your rooms and have time to freshen up for a Farewell Dinner and Theater experience with Theater Newfoundland.
